We support strong oral health through quality dental services, ongoing education and community outreach projects.



General dental services

Our dental service is based at 11 Glenlyon Road, Brunswick and provides dental treatment under the guidelines of Dental Health Services Victoria.

We can help with:

- > Dental check-ups and advice
- > Dental sealants to prevent decay
- > Teeth cleaning
- > Fillings
- > Extractions
- > Denture services
- > And more!

The dental team includes dentists, dental assistants, oral health therapists, a dental prosthetist, and reception staff.

We are committed to giving you the highest quality and most appropriate dental care that is available. Our dental team will provide you with information and advice as well as treatment, on how you can best look after your teeth and keep them for life.

Children's dental

Our dental service is free for eligible children aged 0-12 years. This service includes priority access/next available appointment and provides general oral health care and advice.

Community outreach programs

Our dental service provides two community outreach programs. Our team go out to see the community to help with dental education and screenings. Our two programs are called Little Smiles and Smile 4 Miles.



Little Smiles

Little Smiles provide education sessions and dental screenings for children and their families in a range of high risk playgroups across Moreland.

Smiles 4 Miles

The Smiles 4 Miles coordinator at Merri Health works with high risk early childhood services in the Moreland area to improve the oral health of pre-school aged children. The program engages children, their families, educators, staff, management and the broader community to create a healthy environment. The registered early childhood services are also offered dental screenings every year.

NDIS made easy

Merri Health provides many services under the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) as it rolls out across Victoria. This includes:

Allied health

Support from an occupational therapist, speech pathologist and dietitian for people with all types of disabilities. We offer face-to-face appointments and assessments in your home or at a location that suits you, home modifications, Assistive Technology, referrals to other services, easy to read reports for your NDIS planner or Local Area Coordinator, and functional assessments to build your capacity and independence.

MerriKids

MerriKids support children with a developmental delay and/or disabilities, and their families. Providing early childhood intervention, our team works in partnership with you to develop strategies to support the health and wellbeing of your child.

Support coordination

A skilled and experienced worker will help you identify, coordinate and meet your needs. We will work in partnership with you to help you access the supports and services you want and need to live a fulfilling and happy life.

This could involve staying connected with your community, finding the right services for you and identifying your needs to ensure your personal goals are met. We will support you when you make decisions about your health to ensure the best outcomes for your personal situation.

Who can use our dental service?

Children

- > All children aged 0-12

Young adults

- > Young adults aged 13-17 years who hold a Health Care or Pension Concession Card, or dependants of concession card holders
- > Young adults up to 18 years of age, who are in out-of home care provided by the State government
- > All refugees and asylum seekers
- > Young adults eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Scheme

Adults

- > People aged 18 years and over, who are health care or pensioner concession card holders or dependants of concession card holders
- > All refugees and asylum seekers

There is a waiting time for adults to access general dental care, however if you are in pain, you are able to call and access an emergency appointment to assess and treat specific problem.

Costs
