General dental services

Our dental service is based at 11 Glenlyon Road, Brunswick and provides dental treatment under the guidelines of Dental Health Services Victoria.

We can help with:

- > Dental check-ups and advice
- Dental sealants to prevent decay
- Teeth cleaning
- Fillings

The dental team includes dentists, dental assistants, oral health therapists, oral health educators, a dental prosthetist, and reception staff.

We are committed to giving you the highest quality and most appropriate dental care that is available. Our dental team will provide you with information and advice as well as treatment, on how you can best look after your teeth and keep them for life.

Children's dental

Our dental service is free for all children up to the age of 12 years and for eligible children between 13-18 years. This service includes priority access/next available appointment and provides general oral health care and advice.

Community outreach programs


Our dental service provides two community outreach programs. Our team go out to see the community to help with dental education and screenings. Our two programs are called Little Smiles and Smile 4 Miles.

Little Smiles

Little Smiles provide education sessions and dental screenings for children and their families in a range of high risk playgroups across Merri-bek.

Smiles 4 Miles

The Smiles 4 Miles coordinator at Merri Health works with high risk early childhood services in the Merri-bek area to improve the oral health of pre-school aged children. The program engages children, their families, educators, staff, management and the broader community to create a healthy environment. The registered early childhood services are also offered dental screenings every year.



Smile Squad

Smile Squad is a Victorian Government program that offers free dental care to all Victorian government school students. The dental team at Merri Health are currently participating in this program. We are visiting government schools in the inner northern suburbs to provide free check-ups. Please contact your child's school to see when Smile Squad is scheduled to visit your school.



Who can use our dental service?

Children

> All children aged 0-12

Young adults

- > Young adults aged 13-18 years who hold a Health Care or Pension Concession Card, or dependants of concession card holders
- Young adults up to 18 years of age, who are in out-of home care provided by the State government
- > All refugees and asylum seekers
- > Young adults eligible for the Child Dental Benefits Scheme

Adults

- People aged 18 years and over, who are health care or pensioner concession card holders or dependants of concession card holders
- > All refugees and asylum seekers

There is a waiting time for adults to access general dental care, however if you are in pain, you are able to call and access an emergency appointment to assess and treat a specific problem.

Costs
