Thanks for your enquiry about Kinder Partnerships.

Merri Health is offering allied health services to kindergarten programs through the **School Readiness Funding (SRF)** menu items 'Allied Health: Multi-disciplinary teams (arranged by services independently)' and 'Speech Pathologist (arranged by services independently)'.

The purpose of the program is to provide support for early childhood educators and teachers to enhance children's learning outcomes in the areas of communication, wellbeing, and access and inclusion.

The **Kinder Partnerships team** can currently offer **Speech Pathology** support. The team will work with you to develop an individualised package to meet the needs of your service and address your learning objectives. The Kinder Partnerships team is not able to provide assessment and support to individual children within the service. The areas we can provide support in are:

- Communication language, speech, fluency
- Play and social skills
- Pre-literacy
- Emotional regulation and behaviour
- Self-care skills toileting, eating, dressing
- Kinder and school preparedness



We can support you by providing:

- Professional development through workshops, presentations and case discussions
- Observation, coaching and mentoring visits to early childhood settings
- Parent/carer workshops, handouts and resource development
- Information about local services and how you can refer children, e.g. local allied health services, NDIS, etc.
- Support with having challenging conversations with families
