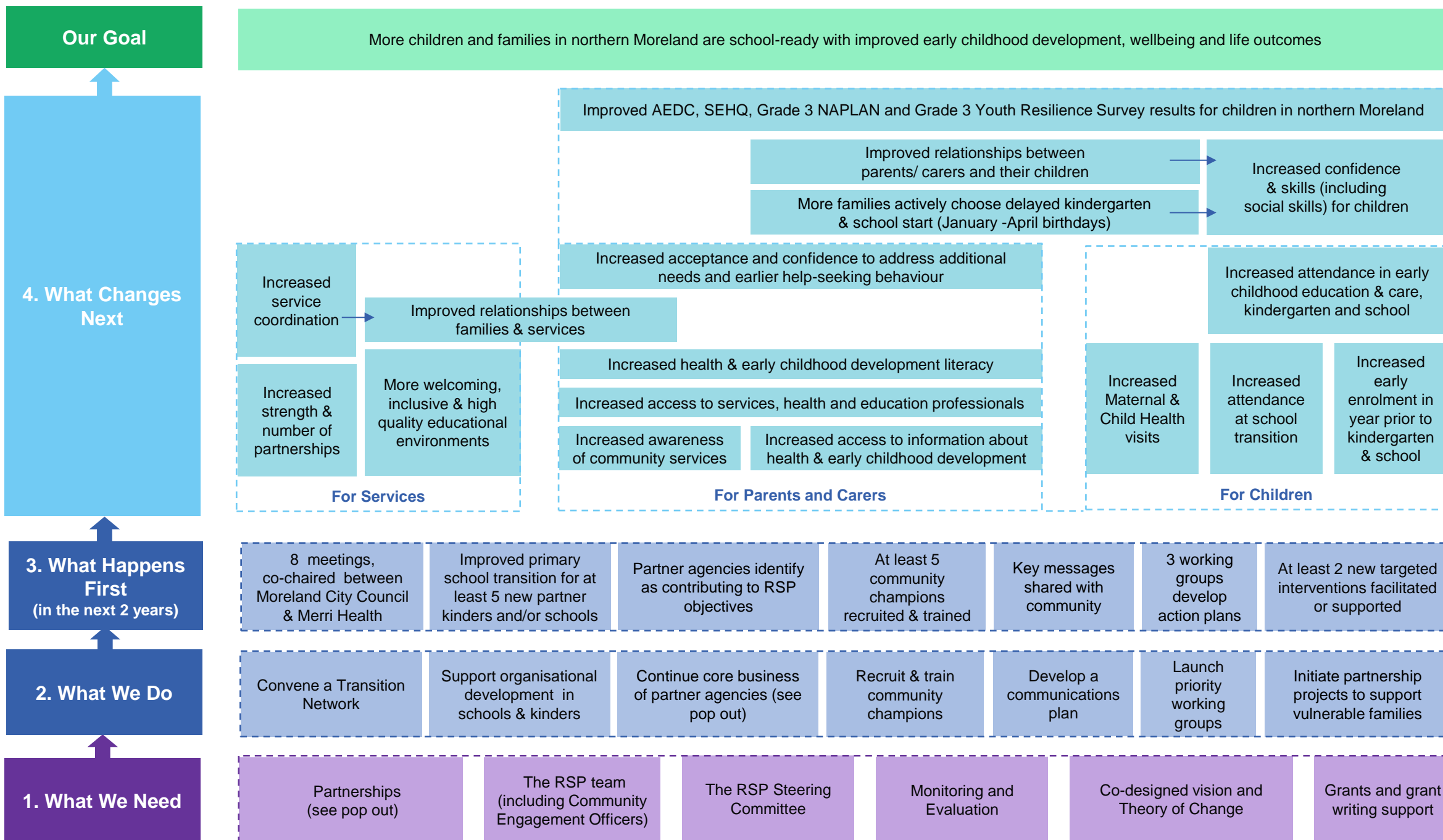


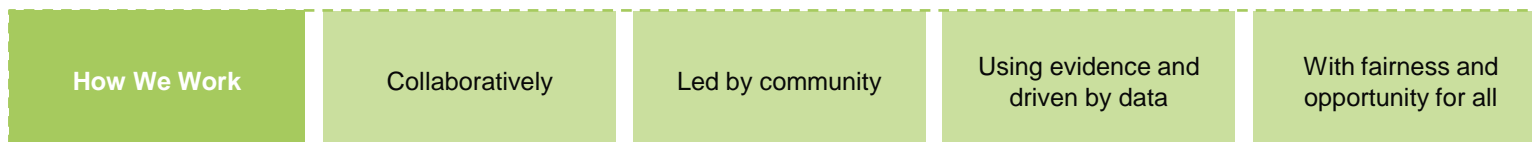
Ready, Set, Prep! Theory of Change 2021-2022
